Turf Fees

- The Thursday night Raffles have been going well.

The following Monday was the Tweed Border Delegates Meeting. From this meeting the important points were:

- Last month it had been proposed that this meeting be the usual format but with distinct Junior and Senior sections This meeting found that discussing Junior business led into Senior business and so forth
- This meeting felt the use of 'Tomahawks' should be a coaching related issue but the meeting agreed that clarification from Qld Hockey be gained to find out to what extent it is allowed.
- Some of the vacant positions mentioned last month have been filled ie Women's Registrar, Promotions manager, Delegates President and Secretary.
- The first installment for Registration fees is due 17th April.
- Those that want to umpire this year are asked to contact me. Senior Umpires are paid \$15 /game (badged \$25/game). With a minimum of 5 games throughout the season so as to qualify to get paid. A list of available umpires is to be supplied to Sandra Clarke ASAP so as to have available umpires for the first game of the season. This list is to mention the availability and the ability of the umpires. These umpires are to attend meeting throughout the year.
- The Tweed Border Hockey has proposed another turf be laid. Funding has been approved. Is this good for the Associated Clubs?
- As to whether the Tweed Border Hockey should place what club's must pay in registration fees to Tweed Border on the WEB. The discussion that ensued felt most other club's didn't mind this at all.

Dress Code
