Community Coach Training Program

The Australian Sports Commission's Active After-school Communities program is offering training for interested community-minded participants to train as community coaches.

The role of the Community Coach will be to deliver structured physical activity programs using the 'Playing for Life' philosophy to primary school aged children in the after school hours.

Who is a Community Coach?

Community Coaches can come from a variety of backgrounds including working with children, sports coaching, teaching, tertiary studies or community minded people who have a passion for enhancing children's physical activity levels.

What will we learn?

The training is geared to prepare you for your role as a Community Coach. The topics covered in the proposed courses will be Modules 1 (Role of the Coach) and 5 (Playing for Life philosophy) only.

If you have NCAS Coaching Accreditations, Teaching or Childcare Qualifications you will receive Automatic Credit for Modules 2, 3 and 4 (**Note: you must provide current proof attached to your enrolment form**). If you do not have the stated qualifications you will need to complete these modules on-line (prior to the course) in order to complete all requirements of the Community Coach Training Program.

How to access the on-line course?

The *Beginning Coaching General Principles* course is available from the Australian Sports Commission's new online learning portal. Go to: <https://learning.ausport.gov.au> for more information on the course, and to enrol.

The Community Coach Training Program also meets all the requirements of the Beginning Coaching General Principles course. Note: This does not qualify you as an accredited coach within the National Coaching Accreditation Scheme. To become an accredited coach, you must also complete the sport specific requirements as stipulated by the relevant national sporting organisation.
